Each child is encouraged to be an active and involved learner with the guidance and support of our educators.



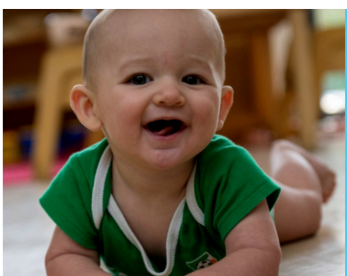
Our preschool environment provide opportunities for children to play while learning.

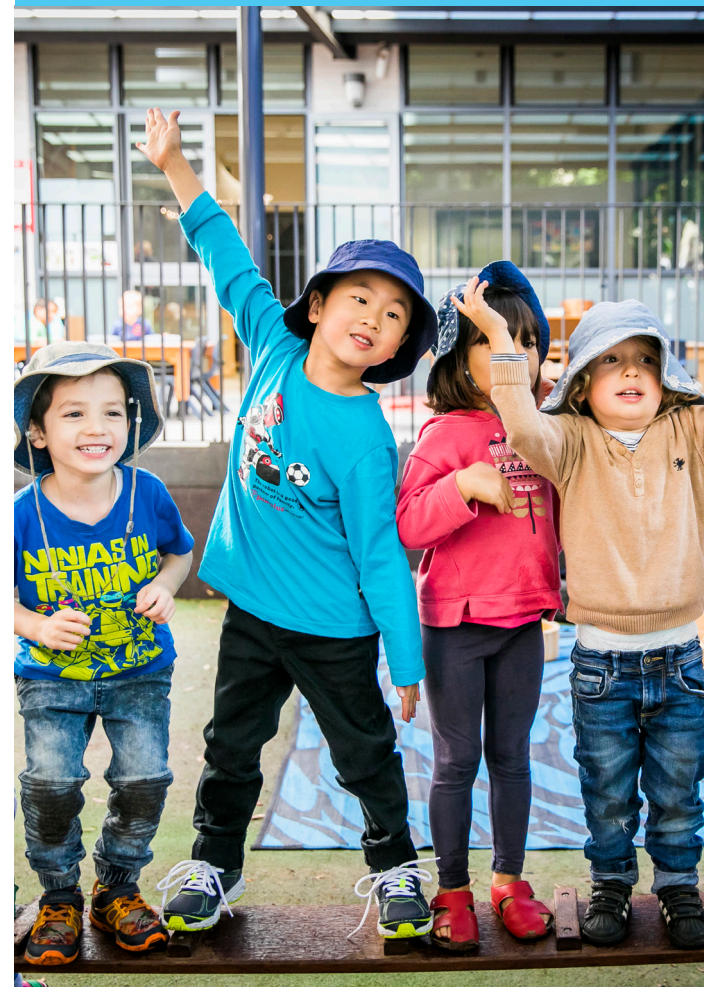

Our service has been rated as Exceeding National Quality Standards by ACECQA and offers early education and care for a small group of 36 children each day, for children from 6 weeks to 6 years of age.

Our modern, purpose built facility includes environmentally friendly design features and is centrally located to the city with a rare leafy outdoor play area.

Our passionate, highly trained and experienced team includes University trained Teachers, Diplomas and Certificate III educators who offer a comprehensive, individually based, early education program.

Our Learning Environments

Our learning environments are designed to support both small group and individual learning experiences, and our furnishings and equipment are chosen carefully to help create a warm, natural and home-like service.

There are opportunities for both age grouped, and family grouped experiences throughout the day, and children are encouraged and supported to be proactive in co-creating their learning opportunities.

Our play-based curriculum incorporates a School Readiness Program that has been developed with reference to the developmental needs of children in their first year of school.

We are open 50 weeks per year, from 8am to 6pm Monday to Friday.

Nutritious meals are provided, prepared daily by our fully qualified cook.



Frequently Asked Questions

Is there a fee to join the waiting list?

No, there is no fee to join our waiting list.

How should I submit my waiting list?

By mailbox or by scanning and emailing. By doing this, you will have a digital copy of your application, and you will also have made your first email communication with the service.

What is the best method of contact for enquiries regarding the progress of my application?

An email is the preferred method of contact for; enquiries regarding your waiting list application, to update your waiting list details (changes of name, D.O.B, days of care required etc), to periodically express your ongoing interest in a position (eg, 6 weeks prior to your desired start date, then if no available positions at the time, every few months) or to withdraw your application.

Can we come in and see the centre?

Yes ! We look forward to taking you through our service. Centre visits usually take around 45 minutes. Please call or email to make an appointment.
